This last year (2020) was the first class of university graduates, since 2003. The first Hebron high school graduating class of 2017 consisted of only 12 students. However, all of them were selected for college/university, and this is generally unheard of. Out of those graduates, we have a statistician, lawyer with political science emphasis, pharmacist, city planner, and a handful of teachers, among other professions.

Evelyn Boniface Nnko is among those who have graduated, and with her teaching credentials. Shortly after, she started volunteering at Hebron Secondary School. We are excited to report that this January, she was hired on to become a full-time employee at our high school. Evelyn is a testament to God's faithfulness, and your unwavering support for the students of Sakila. Our desire was to see our own students come back to Sakila as leaders, for this next generation. The

dream is becoming the reality!
