Dear Sponsors and Supporters,

Our Form 6 students took their National Exams from May 3-17th. If they receive a Division One status, the government will choose a school for them, and pay up to 75% of their tuition and fees. If they receive a Division Two or Three, they will move on to the university of their choice, that accepts them. If they receive a Division Four, they will move on to vocational training elsewhere. Here is the school schedule for each Standard and Form in Tanzania. In Standard 1-7 (Primary School) and Form 1-4 (Lower Secondary School), students will start the new school year from mid-January until mid-November. Generally, they will have graduations before they finish their academic school year. This is why graduations are in October. There



are two yearly breaks from mid-June to mid-July, and then again mid-December to mid-January. Form 5-6 (Upper Secondary School with an equivalency to our Associates Degree in college), start their academic school year from mid-July until mid-May. If they pass their Form 6 national exams and choose to go to a university, they will head to school in October, and finish in July of each year.

Questions You May Have

Why are there only six students listed for taking the Form 6 National Exam, when there are 58 students in Form 6?

We have 58 Form 6 Hebron students who are boarding at the school, from July until May. Only six students have come all the way up from Sluys/Anderson Primary School. The rest of the students come from all over the country to board at Hebron.

Why are the Christ Hope Orphanage (CHO) students listed? We have many sponsors and supporters who support orphan students from CHO at Hebron, and students with the Sakila Sponsorship Program. As soon as the CHO orphans graduate from Standard 7 (Primary School) in Arusha, they automatically board at Hebron for Forms 1-6 (Lower and Upper Secondary School). This is the first year of Form 6 graduates from CHO. Praise God!
