This last school year (Jan. 2020 - Dec. 2020) started off a bit disjointed, but we are thankful that the students were able to return to school and continue their studies to complete the school year. This has not been the case for many of our neighboring countries. As the pandemic surged, the government issued a directive on how to deal with the virus, which we were able to implement swiftly. To date, we are happy and thankful to report that our schools continue to thrive.

Despite all the challenges that the schools went through, our students have continued to perform extremely well. Our High School Class of 2020, all passed their national examinations. The lowest passing grade was a C+, and our percentages set a new school record.

As we start this new school year, many obstacles stand in our way, but we ask that you'd please continue to pray that our needs will be met. Our greatest need continues to be food (rice, corn and beans). With over 1000 students each year, we consume over 60 tons of corn at a price of \$230 per ton, sixteen tons of beans at a price of \$390 per ton and 26 tons of rice, which costs \$782 per ton. We ask that you please partner with us to meet this need. Anything you can give will help.

Again, we have deep gratitude for your continued prayers and financial support. You are an essential part of this work, and share in its success.
